Revenue-Generating Children's Spaces

The Challenge: Design a children's space perfect for parties that will bring in a new source of revenue.

The Solution: With the addition of party rooms and the renovation of the existing play room, parents now have both a place to throw their child's next party and a place for their kids to play while they exercise.

- Through the use of abstract paint schemes and floor patterns that mimic themes found in nature, the play and party rooms offer kids a land of fantasy.
- In the party rooms, kids can look out the randomly sized and placed exterior windows that collide with geometric paint and floor patterns which reflect the variety of heights and sizes of children.
- In the play room, children can play in the tube play structure, hop over the river floor pattern or explore near the jungle wall.



The Result: The design creates spaces that are fun, adventurous and flexible while generating a new source of revenue.
